

Intelligence Law Course

Updated as of 10 JUNE

The 16th Intelligence Law Course originally scheduled for 17-21 August 2020 has been postponed due to considerations related to COVID-19. A decision will be made in mid-July to determine if the course can be held in early October. Dates and course format are subject to change as more facts and guidance related to COVID-19 become available. The Intelligence Law Course is a five-day course intended primarily for judge advocates and government civilian attorneys who are new to the field of intelligence law and who are assigned or pending assignment to a billet where the attorney will be advising on intelligence and related activities. This course will be held at the SECRET level and will be by invitation only. Additional information will be provided through follow up announcements as it becomes available.
