

Intermediate Paralegal Course 1 (IPC1)

Course Length: 60 Days (Self-paced)

Prerequisites: applicable for Paralegal NCOs only

- a. Must be a Staff Sergeant or Sergeant.
- b. Must be a graduate of BLC or WLC.
- c. Must have completed SSD-2.
- d. Must possess a security clearance of at least Secret.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

IPC1 is a 60-day, self-paced distributed learning course open to civilian paralegals and eligible paralegal NCOs. It is a mandatory graduation requirement for paralegals NCO attending ALC. The course is designed similarly to online college courses and will guide you through skill level two and three Paralegal NCO skills. You will receive training on broad-scope office management, criminal law, pretrial procedures, and referral to courts-martial, military paralegal correspondence, and legal assistance.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

IPC2 is a 60-day self-paced distributed learning course open to civilian paralegals and eligible paralegal NCOs. It is a mandatory graduation requirement for paralegal NCOs attending SLC. The course is designed similarly to online college courses and will guide you through skill level three and four Paralegal NCO skills. You will receive training on broad-scope operational planning, leadership, financial liability investigations of property loss, manpower management, and review of common legal documents.
